ANCHORING:

Depending on the number of boats in our rag tag fleet, we will either anchor or pick up a mooring next to Warren Island or anchor in the large area at the north area of Gilkey Harbor.

ACTIVITIES:

The trails on Warren Island are easy and the views are, of course, terrific. If the seas are calm enough for a long dinghy ride, the town of Dark Harbor in Ames Cove is fun to walk around. If I remember correctly, there is a very fine ice cream parlor and a good book store. No guarantee of a John Travolta sighting.
